**Acute Rhinitis (nasal cold)**  
 An acute, progressive, infectious, edematous inflammation of the nasal mucosa and/or other structures in the nasal cavity.

**Causes**

1. Viral (90% of all cases caused by rhinovirus infection) but also bacteriological, allergic, drug-induced.
2. Infection by bacteria, in other organisms the infection stage is the viral infection.
3. Allergic (allergy of the nasal mucosa contributes to the course of the viral and bacterial infection caused by virus infection).
4. Accompanying other infectious diseases, such as measles, flu.

**Symptoms**  
 Rhinorrhea, nasal congestion, nasal itching, sneezing, itching, itching, with the nasal discharge, loss of olfactory acuity, loss of taste, malaise, and occasionally accompanying edema with swelling of the nasal mucosa.

**Treatment**  
 Treatment of viral rhinitis can be alleviated by rinsing the nasal cavity with saline solution. The use of vasoconstrictors in the form of drops or sprays is not recommended. In the case of bacterial infection, the use of antibiotics is not recommended. In the case of allergic rhinitis, the use of antihistamines is recommended.

**Acute Rhinitis (infection of the paranasal sinuses)**  
 Due to the acute inflammation of the nasal cavity and paranasal sinuses, inflammation of the mucosa of the paranasal sinuses. Inflammation of the mucosa of the paranasal sinuses is characterized by the following signs:

 The nasal cavity  
 The nasal discharge

**Causes**

1. Viral (rhinovirus, adenovirus, influenza)
2. Bacterial (Staphylococcus aureus, Streptococcus pneumoniae)
3. Allergic
4. Secondary to an infection in the nasal cavity (acute rhinitis) or to a bacterial infection (acute rhinitis).
5. Spreading of the infection from other sites (otitis media, otitis externa, otitis interna).

**Symptoms**  
 In the case of infection of the nasal cavity (acute rhinitis), the symptoms are similar to those of acute rhinitis. However, the symptoms are more pronounced and last longer. The symptoms are: nasal discharge, nasal congestion, nasal itching, sneezing, itching, itching, with the nasal discharge, loss of olfactory acuity, loss of taste, malaise, and occasionally accompanying edema with swelling of the nasal mucosa.

**Chronic Rhinitis**

**Causes**

1. Chronic rhinitis
2. Infection of the paranasal sinuses
3. Allergic rhinitis, which is the most common form of chronic rhinitis. It is characterized by a long-term inflammation of the nasal mucosa and is accompanied by a long-term nasal discharge.
4. Accompanying other infectious diseases, such as measles, flu.

**Chronic Rhinitis**  
 The inflammation of the nasal mucosa is a long-term inflammation of the nasal mucosa.
