


VR1251UU - Rhinitis and sinusitis

Acute Rhinitis (nasal cold)
 An acute, progressive, irritative inflammation of the nasal mucosa caused by other diseases or viral cold.

Causes:
 1. Viral (80% of all cases caused by rhinovirus, followed by influenza, adenovirus, herpes simplex).
 2. Irritants: dust, smoke, alcohol, fumes, etc.
 3. Allergic: allergic rhinitis or vasomotor rhinitis.
 4. Secondary: following other diseases, such as measles, typhoid.

Symptoms:
 Irritation, redness, swelling, itching, tearing, discharge from the nose, sneezing, congestion, loss of sense of smell, headache, fever, malaise, general weakness.

Treatment:
 Supportive care: rest, fluids, humidifier, saline nasal sprays, decongestants (short-term use), antihistamines (if allergic).

Acute Rhinitis (infection of the paranasal sinuses)
 An acute infection of the paranasal sinuses, usually caused by a viral infection of the upper respiratory tract.

Symptoms:
 Discharge of yellow or green mucus, facial pain, swelling, tenderness, fever, malaise, general weakness.

Changes to the nasal cavity and the paranasal sinuses during rhinitis (nasal infection)

Structure of the paranasal sinuses

Changes caused by rhinitis showing the close anatomical proximity to neighboring organs

Diagnosis of rhinitis:
 1. History and physical examination.
 2. Allergy testing (skin or blood tests).
 3. Imaging (CT scan) to rule out structural abnormalities.

Treatment of acute and chronic rhinitis:
 Supportive care: rest, fluids, humidifier, saline nasal sprays, decongestants (short-term use), antihistamines (if allergic), corticosteroids (for chronic rhinitis).
